Mobile Toilet Trailer Units Risk Assessment / Method Statement

### **Delivery & Installation + Collection & Removal**

Upon arrival on site the driver will park his vehicle in a position with the hazard lights turned on so as to minimise any disruption to other road users. The hazard lights will remain switched on throughout the installation process.

The driver will then assess the access route for potential problems and to insure that there will be no risk of damage or injury to any vehicles, property or individuals during the installation process.

It is company policy that the driver is not permitted to take trailer maneuvering directions from anyone other than another company employee. Set up and testing

The driver will follow company procedures for the set-up of the unit to ensure that the trailer chassis is fully covered, the handbrake is on and functioning correctly and that the steps are stable and correctly adjusted.

All units will be tested by the driver when power is available to ensure the correct functioning of the unit. Each unit is fitted with an RCD trip device to ensure safe power distribution. Each toilet will be flushed and each tap run to ensure that everything is functioning correctly. Hazards

- Each trailer has a locked service area which contains the electrical distribution equipment. All electrical distribution equipment will be marked with a 'Hazard / 240v' sign to warn of the potential danger.
- Access to the trailer unit is by mounting three steps, each with a elevation of approx. 230mm. A grab rail is provided to the side of the steps.
- When in re-circulating mode the unit WC bowls contains a mixture of chemical and water which may cause irritation if it comes into contact with the skin. Guest Operation of the Toilets

All toilet facilities within the unit work in precisely the same manner as domestic facilities and therefore present a minimal risk to users. An attendant will be present whenever the toilets are in use to assist anyone who may be having difficulties. Emptying and cleaning

Any pump outs booked will be undertaken by either a company technician or a suitably trained outside contractor. The use of the toilets will not be permitted whilst this is in progress. Where an attendant has been booked they will clean the unit as appropriate, taking every effort to minimise the disruption to guests and maximising client comfort.
